13 Art festival in Nantes

On the Loire River, Nantes has quietly become France's coolest city. That's a lot to do with its summer-long arts festival, Le Voyage à Nantes (until November 4, levoyageanantes.fr), in which DJs, designers, gardeners and graffiti artists all do their thing along a green-lined trail, which stays open all year. Among its permanent works are 200m-long dragons. Also key was 2017's reopening of the Musée d'Arts de Nantes (museedartsdenantes.nantesmetropole.fr); from June 1 to September 2, it hosts installations by James Turrell.

Where to stay La Perouse's slanted, boxy exterior has deservedly earned architectural awards. Inside is a cognac bar and arty rooms boasting Rietveld zigzag chairs. B&B doubles cost from £120, including Musée d'Arts admission (00 33 240 89 75 00, hotel-laperouse.fr)
